Also Rosettes for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th in all classes

Dogs that have won any of the following are not eligible for entry into the pedigree classes:

- Challenge Certificate (or any award that counts towards the title of Champion under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club)
- Reserve Challenge Certificates
- Junior Warrant

Note: Only legally docked or undocked dogs are eligible for competition at Companion Dog Shows
