It is with great sadness that we learned of the death of Tina Humphrey in May 2017. Tina and Chandi, specialising in "Heelwork to Music", performed at our show no fewer that 6 times between 2002 and 2010, and were always a great favourite with the crowd.

Chandi was a rescue Blue Merle Border Collie, and together they took the country by storm, winning four Crufts HWTM finals, and appearing in several television programmes, including "When will I be Famous?", "Blue Peter", and "Richard and Judy", culminating in 2010 when they were finalists in "Britain's Got Talent" which catapulted them to stardom. Tragically, Chandi died in April 2013.

In 2012, Tina published her book entitled "Chandi – the rescue dog who stole the nations heart".

Tina (45), a former school music teacher in Shrewsbury, will be greatly missed by everybody, especially her husband Steve, who kindly agreed to us including this dedication in Tina's memory. It was Tina's request that any donations should be made to Hilbrae Rescue Kennels, Telford, TF6 6QJ, where she found Chandi.

Tina not only had a beautiful way with animals, but she was a great people person too, and loved coming to the Alfrick Show.

Together with Chandi, she has given many of us so many happy memories of the special bond they developed and the amazing joy of watching them perform together.
