SECTION A – NOVELTY – OPEN

THE LEIGH & DISTRICT GARDENERS' CLUB TROPHY will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 1-5.

PRIZES (each class): 1st, £1.50; 2nd, £1; 3rd, 50p.

ENTRANCE FEE: 30p per class

CLASS

- 1 3 Tomatoes of the same variety, to be judged on taste
- 2 Heaviest courgette or marrow
- 3 A cactus/succulent in a pot. Pot not to exceed 9"/23cm
- 4 An oddly shaped fruit or vegetable
- 5 The most colourful apple

SECTION B – VEGETABLES

Open to residents of the parishes of Alfrick & Lulsley, Leigh & Bransford and Suckley.

THE NEW CORONATION CUP will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 6-13.

PRIZES (each class): 1st, £1.50; 2nd, £1; 3rd, 50p.

ENTRANCE FEE: 30p per class

CLASS

- 6 3 Potatoes of the same variety
- 7 3 Onions grown from sets
- 8 9 Runner beans
- 9 3 Beet, round
- 10 3 Carrots, stumped
- 11 3 Courgettes
- 12 A truss of cherry tomatoes
- 13 5 Shallots

- *Try to select entries of a uniform size and shape*
- *Leave roots on carrots and cut tops off, leaving about 75mm*
- *Courgettes should be 100mm - 200mm long, approximately 35mm diameter, with or without flowers*

SECTION C – VEGETABLES – OPEN

The **RAVENHILL CHALLENGE CUP** will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 14-32.

PRIZES (each class): 1st, £1.50; 2nd, £1; 3rd, 50p.

ENTRANCE FEE: 30p per class

CLASS

- 14 Versatile Gardener Competition
A display of a vase of mixed flowers plus 3 each of 3 different kinds of vegetables, within an area measuring 2' x 2'/60cm x 60cm maximum
- 15 3 Potatoes, white, any shape
- 16 3 Potatoes, coloured, any shape
- 17 6 Chilli peppers
- 18 9 Shallots, pickling, 30mm maximum diameter
- 19 3 Onions grown from seed
- 20 3 Carrots, long
- 21 3 Beet, round
- 22 9 Runner beans
- 23 9 French beans
- 24 5 Tomatoes – traditional
- 25 5 Tomatoes – unusual variety (5 of the same kind)
- 26 2 Parsnips
- 27 2 Leeks
- 28 A pair of marrows
- 29 Any other vegetable (2 of the same kind)
- 30 2 Cucumbers of the same variety
- 31 3 Salad vegetables (1 each of 3 different kinds)
- 32 A presentation of vegetables in a box: 2' x 2'/60cm x 60cm maximum

The same variety means, for example, all Sungold tomatoes, all Diva cucumbers, etc.

The same kind means all turnips, all cabbages, etc.

Class 14: This is a presentation, not a collection, so keep it balanced and don't overload. Vegetables can include salad vegetables

SECTION D – FRUIT – OPEN

The **FRANK CLIFT CHALLENGE CUP** will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 33-37.

PRIZES (each class): 1st, £1.50; 2nd, £1; 3rd, 50p.

ENTRANCE FEE: 30p per class

CLASS

- 33 9 Stone fruit of the same variety
- 34 5 Cooking apples of the same variety
- 35 5 Dessert apples of the same variety
- 36 10 Soft fruits on a plate, all the same kind
- 37 Any other fruit(s), all the same kind

The same variety means, for example, all Victoria plums, all Bramley apples, etc.
The same kind means all raspberries, all blackberries, all pears, etc.

SECTION E – FLOWERS

Open to residents of the parishes of Alfrick & Lulsley, Leigh & Bransford and Suckley.

BERROWS WORCESTER JOURNAL CHALLENGE CUP will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 38-43.

PRIZES (each class): 1st, £1.50; 2nd, £1; 3rd, 50p.

ENTRANCE FEE: 30p per class

CLASS

- 38 A vase of sweet peas, annual and/or perennial
- 39 5 Stems of penstemon, can be mixed varieties
- 40 5 Stems of salvia, can be mixed varieties
- 41 1 Stem of hydrangea
- 42 3 Stems of sedum, any colour
- 43 A collection of foliage

SECTION F – FLOWERS – OPEN

The **GREENLEAVES ROSE BOWL** will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 44-48.

PRIZES (each class): 1st, £1.50; 2nd, £1; 3rd, 50p.

ENTRANCE FEE: 30p per class

CLASS

- 44 3 Hybrid tea roses in one container
- 45 A specimen rose
- 46 3 Stems of floribunda roses in one container
- 47 A vase of roses, can be mixed
- 48 1 Stem of your favourite perfumed rose

THE ALFRICK & LULSLEY HORTICULTURAL SHOW and SPORTS CUP

will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 49-53.

- 49 3 Decorative dahlias, in one container
- 50 3 Cactus or semi-cactus dahlias, in one container
- 51 3 Ball or small ball dahlias, in one container
- 52 3 Pompon dahlias, in one container
- 53 A container of mixed dahlias, not less than 6 blooms, not more than 12

THE GREENLEAVES TROPHY will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 54-66.

- 54 Pot plant, fuchsia. Pot not to exceed 9"/23 cm
- 55 Pot plant, pelargonium (geranium). Pot not to exceed 9"/23 cm
- 56 Pot plant, flowering (other than pelargonium or fuchsia). Pot not to exceed 9"/23cm
- 57 Pot plant, foliage. Pot not to exceed 9"/23 cm
- 58 A vase containing 5 different kinds of flowers, excluding shrubs
- 59 Your favourite single bloom
- 60 A vase containing a mixed collection of berries and/or seed heads
- 61 Single stem of a multibloom not appearing elsewhere in this Schedule
- 62 5 Stems of flowering perennials, same colour and variety
- 63 5 Stems of cosmos
- 64 A collection of 4 culinary herbs
- 65 5 Stems of French marigolds
- 66 5 Flower heads of fuchsia, all the same variety, single or double

- *Pots should be clean*
- *Staking, wiring or tying should not detract from the exhibit*

SECTION G – HOME-MADE WINE & DRINKS OPEN

THE TALBOT AT KNIGHTWICK TROPHY FOR HOME-MADE WINE will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 67-72.

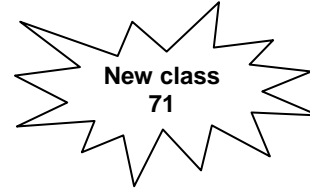
THE HOP POCKET WINE TROPHY will be awarded for the best individual entry in this Section.

PRIZES (each class): 1st, £1.50; 2nd, £1; 3rd, 50p.

ENTRANCE FEE: 30p per class

CLASS

- 67 Bottle of red wine
- 68 Bottle of white wine
- 69 Bottle of damson gin
- 70 Bottle of fruit spirit or liqueur (e.g. sloe gin, limoncello, etc.)
- 71 Bottle of cider
- 72 Bottle of home-made non-alcoholic drink (e.g. apple juice, carrot juice, elderflower cordial, etc.)



Entries should be

- home-made by the exhibitor mainly from natural ingredients, not from a kit;
- exhibited in suitable bottles;
- labelled to show the principal ingredient and year of bottling.

- *The bottle must be easy to open for judging*
- *Judged on taste not the pretty label*

SECTION H – HONEY – OPEN

THE ALFRICK & LULSLEY SHOW HONEY CUP will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 73-78.

PRIZES (each class): 1st, £1.50; 2nd, £1; 3rd, 50p.

ENTRANCE FEE: 30p per class

CLASS

- 73 2 1lb Jars of clear honey, any colour
- 74 2 1lb Jars of granulated or creamed honey
- 75 A frame of honey for extraction
- 76 A piece of beeswax weighing between 112 and 224 grams
- 77 A bottle of mead
- 78 A honey cake (own recipe)

SECTION I – W.I. – OPEN TO EVERYONE

THE ALFRICK & LULSLEY HORTICULTURAL SHOW WOMEN'S INSTITUTE CHALLENGE CUP will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 79-95

- 103 Make a family of animals, using a cut-up egg box
- 104 Make and decorate a gingerbread person

SECTION M – OPEN CHILDREN 8 to 11 YEARS (inclusive)

THE GREENLEAVES JUNIOR TROPHY will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 105-107.

NO ENTRANCE FEE

CLASS

- 105 Make a mini-greenhouse out of lolly sticks, and add accessories as you wish
- 106 Make a chocolate cake to look like a hedgehog
- 107 One vegetable that you have grown
