**SECTION A – NOVELTY – OPEN**

The **LEIGH & DISTRICT GARDENERS' CLUB TROPHY** will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 1-5.

**PRIZES** (each class): 1st, £1.50; 2nd, £1; 3rd, 50p.

**ENTRANCE FEE:** 30p per class

**CLASS**

- 1 3 Tomatoes of the same named variety, to be judged on taste
- 2 The longest bean
- 3 The largest sunflower, head only, on a plate/dish
- 4 An oddly shaped fruit or vegetable
- 5 A giant vegetable

**SECTION B – VEGETABLES**

Open to residents of the parishes of Alfrick & Lulsley, Leigh & Bransford and Suckley.

The **NEW CORONATION CUP** will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 6-17.

**PRIZES** (each class): 1st, £1.50; 2nd, £1; 3rd, 50p.

**ENTRANCE FEE:** 30p per class

**CLASS**

- 6 3 Potatoes of the same variety
- 7 3 Onions grown from sets
- 8 9 Runner beans
- 9 9 French beans
- 10 3 Beetroot, round
- 11 3 Carrots of the same variety
- 12 3 Courgettes
- 13 A truss of cherry tomatoes
- 14 5 Tomatoes, small fruited and cherry varieties, max. 35mm diameter
- 15 5 Tomatoes, medium, 35mm - 65mm diameter
- 16 6 Chilli peppers
- 17 1 Lettuce, any variety

- *Beans should be cut from the vine with scissors, leaving a short stalk*
- *Leave roots on carrots and cut green tops off, leaving about 75mm*
- *Courgettes should be 100mm - 200mm long, approximately 35mm diameter, with or without flowers*

## SECTION C – VEGETABLES – OPEN

The **RAVENHILL CHALLENGE CUP** will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 18-32.

**PRIZES** (each class): 1st, £1.50; 2nd, £1; 3rd, 50p.

**ENTRANCE FEE:** 30p per class

### CLASS

- 18 Versatile Gardener  
A display comprising a vase of mixed flowers, plus 3 each of 3 different kinds of vegetables, within a container measuring 2' x 2'/60cm x 60cm maximum
- 19 3 Potatoes, white, of the same variety
- 20 3 Potatoes, coloured, of the same variety
- 21 3 Onions, grown from seed
- 22 3 Carrots, long
- 23 9 Runner beans
- 24 5 Tomatoes, small fruited and cherry varieties, max. 35mm diameter
- 25 5 Tomatoes, medium, 35mm - 65mm diameter
- 26 2 Parsnips
- 27 2 Leeks
- 28 A pair of marrows, maximum length 350mm
- 29 2 Cucumbers of the same variety
- 30 Any other vegetable (2 of the same kind)
- 31 3 Salad vegetables (1 each of 3 different kinds)
- 32 A presentation of vegetables in a box 2' x 2'/60cm x 60cm maximum

*The same variety means, for example, all Sungold tomatoes, all Bramley apples, etc.  
The same kind means all cauliflowers, all pears, etc.*

## SECTION D – FRUIT – OPEN

The **FRANK CLIFT CHALLENGE CUP** will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 33-37.

**PRIZES** (each class): 1st, £1.50; 2nd, £1; 3rd, 50p.

**ENTRANCE FEE:** 30p per class

### CLASS

- 33 9 Stone fruit of the same variety
- 34 5 Cooking apples of the same variety
- 35 5 Dessert apples of the same variety
- 36 10 Soft fruits on a plate, all the same kind
- 37 Any other fruit(s), all the same kind

- *Fruit should be shown with the bloom on and stalks attached.*

## SECTION E – FLOWERS

Open to residents of the parishes of Alfrick & Lulsley, Leigh & Bransford and Suckley.

**BERROWS WORCESTER JOURNAL CHALLENGE CUP** will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 38-43.

**PRIZES** (each class): 1st, £1.50; 2nd, £1; 3rd, 50p.

**ENTRANCE FEE:** 30p per class

### CLASS

- 38 5 stems of alstroemerias, can be mixed
- 39 5 stems of Japanese anemones, can be mixed
- 40 5 stems of michaelmas daisies, can be mixed
- 41 1 Stem of hydrangea
- 42 3 Stems of sedum, can be mixed
- 43 A collection of foliage

## SECTION F – FLOWERS – OPEN

The **GREENLEAVES ROSE BOWL** will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 44-48.

**PRIZES** (each class): 1st, £1.50; 2nd, £1; 3rd, 50p.

**ENTRANCE FEE:** 30p per class

### CLASS

- 44 3 Hybrid tea roses
- 45 A specimen rose
- 46 3 Stems of floribunda roses
- 47 A vase of roses, can be mixed
- 48 1 Stem of your favourite perfumed rose

The **ALFRICK & LULSLEY HORTICULTURAL SHOW and SPORTS CUP** will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 49-53.

- 49 3 Decorative dahlias
- 50 3 Cactus or semi-cactus dahlias, all the same kind
- 51 3 Collarette or single dahlias, all the same kind
- 52 3 Pompon or ball dahlias, all the same kind
- 53 A container of mixed dahlias, not less than 6 blooms, not more than 12

The **GREENLEAVES TROPHY** will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 54-66.

**The external measurement of the pots the plants are growing in should not exceed 9"/23 cm**

- 54 Pot plant, fuchsia
- 55 Pot plant, pelargonium (geranium)
- 56 Pot plant, flowering (other than pelargonium or fuchsia)
- 57 Pot plant, foliage
- 58 5 Different kinds of flowers, excluding shrubs
- 59 Your favourite single bloom
- 60 A mixed collection of berries and/or seed heads
- 61 Single stem of a multibloom not appearing elsewhere in this Schedule
- 62 5 Stems of flowering perennials, all the same kind
- 63 5 Stems of cosmos, can be mixed varieties
- 64 A collection of 4 culinary herbs - young and fresh, without flower heads
- 65 3 Hosta leaves - can be mixed varieties
- 66 5 Flower heads of fuchsia, single or double, all the same variety

**ENTRANCE FEE:** 30p per class

### CLASS

- 67 Bottle of home-made wine
- 68 Bottle of damson gin
- 69 Bottle of fruit spirit or liqueur, other than damson gin, (e.g. sloe gin, limoncello, etc.)
- 70 Bottle of home-made beer
- 71 Bottle of cider or perry
- 72 Bottle of home-made non-alcoholic drink (e.g. apple juice, carrot juice, elderflower cordial, etc.)

Entries should be

- home-made by the exhibitor mainly from natural ingredients, not from a kit
- exhibited in suitable bottles
- labelled to show the principal ingredient and year of bottling

- *The bottle must be easy to open for judging*
- *Judged on taste*

The **ALFRICK & LULSLEY SHOW HONEY CUP** will be awarded to the exhibitor obtaining the highest number of points in classes 73-78.

**PRIZES** (each class): 1st, £1.50; 2nd, £1; 3rd, 50p.

**ENTRANCE FEE:** 30p per class

### CLASS

- 73 2 1lb Jars of clear honey, any colour
- 74 2 1lb Jars of granulated or creamed honey
- 75 A frame of honey for extraction
- 76 A piece of beeswax weighing between 112 and 224 grams
- 77 A bottle of mead
- 78 A honey cake (given recipe)

## SECTION I – W.I. – OPEN TO EVERYONE

- 83 5 Microwave butterscotch slices (given recipe)
- 84 5 Welsh cakes (own recipe)
- 85 A pear frangipane tart (given recipe)
- 86 A cheese and onion quiche, using short-crust pastry, maximum diameter 9"/23cm (own recipe)

- 96 An arrangement incorporating fresh flowers, foliage, seed heads and berries, maximum overall size 22" x 22" x 27" high/56cm x 56cm x 68cm high. Title: **Burnished Bounty**
- 97 A petite arrangement, maximum overall size 9.8"/25cm (width, height, depth) no floral foam. Title: **Effervescent**
- 98 A container/vase of fresh flowers and foliage - no floral foam. Title: **An Explosion of Colour**

- *Flowers can be bought*
- *Arrangements must not exceed given sizes*

- 102 Stick 3 leaves on a sheet of A4 paper and decorate them to look like imaginary creatures
- 103 Make an edible birds nest
- 104 Decorate a box with items destined for the bin. Box base maximum 12" x 12"/30cm x 30cm
